CLASSICAL COIN GRADING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By signing the front of this form, the customer acknowledges that they have read the Classical Coin Grading Grading Terms and Conditions.

1-Classical Coin Grading will endeavor to grade coins within the time frame, if any, offered as part of a Classical Coin Grading grading service. However, Classical Coin Grading will have no liability whatsoever to the Customer for incidental or consequential damages due to Classical Coin Grading's failure to grade any coin within any time frame. Business days are defined as Monday through Friday, excluding national and local public holidays. Turnaround times do not include mailing time and business days.

2-Classical Coin Grading may not grade coins that bear evidence of harsh cleaning, artificial toning, damaged surfaces, altered surfaces, PVC damage, tooling, or similar impairments. If Classical Coin Grading rejects any coin for grading in accordance with Classical Coin Grading's grading standards and procedures, Classical Coin Grading will charge the service fee regardless, and no refunds will be issued to the Customer.

3-The Customer represents and warrants that they have no knowledge and no reasonable basis to believe that any coin submitted for grading has been altered or tooled in any way. For the purposes of this Agreement, tooled shall mean any coin that has been altered through artificial means, including but not limited to chemical treatments, mechanical alterations, artificial toning, or other modifications intended to enhance its grade, conceal flaws, or mislead grading assessments. The Customer warrants that all information provided hereunder is accurate and reliable and undertakes to promptly correct and update such information if they discover any inaccuracies.

4-Grading involves individual judgments that are subjective and require the exercise of professional opinion, which can change from time to time. Therefore, Classical Coin Grading makes no warranty or representation and shall have no liability whatsoever to the Customer for the grade assigned by Classical Coin Grading to any coin.

5-Classical Coin Grading will exercise reasonable care in handling coins submitted for grading or reholding. However, if Classical Coin Grading determines that the Customer's item was lost or damaged while in Classical Coin Grading's possession, the Customer will be compensated based upon the fair market value of the coin as determined by Classical Coin Grading's standard procedures. The declared value stated on the front of this form is for estimating insurance coverage only, and the fair market value of the coin may be less than the declared value. In no event shall the total liability exceed the declared value of the coin.

6-Classical Coin Grading accepts no liability for coins with soldered and/or glued components, as these types of items can be damaged even when handled properly.

7-Classical Coin Grading will not accept liability for items lost while not in the custody or control of Classical Coin Grading.

8-The Customer must inspect all coins immediately upon receipt, and Classical Coin

Grading disclaims any liability for damage or discrepancies (such as errors pertaining to the description of the coin) unless reported to Classical Coin Grading within five (5) business days of receipt. The Customer agrees to return any incorrectly described coin to Classical Coin Grading upon request for correction and agrees to indemnify and hold Classical Coin Grading harmless from any and all losses and/or claims caused by the circulation or sale of any incorrectly described coin.

9-Classical Coin Grading shall not be liable for any direct loss or damage suffered by the Customer, however caused, in excess of the price of the services.

10-The Customer agrees to pay Classical Coin Grading all fees and other charges when due. Fees paid to Classical Coin Grading are non-refundable once the item begins the grading process.

11-The Customer hereby grants to Classical Coin Grading an assignment of and lien against the property in the amount of any fees and other charges due and payable pursuant to the terms of this Agreement.

12-Classical Coin Grading reserves the right to adjust grading fees if it determines that the declared value has been understated relative to market value or if the submission form has been incorrectly or incompletely filled out.

13-Classical Coin Grading shall have no liability whatsoever to the Customer, or any third party for whom the Customer may be acting, for (i) any personal injury, or (ii) any damage to any item resulting from breaking open a Classical Coin Grading's holder.

14-Classical Coin Grading shall not be liable under any circumstances for any indirect or consequential loss of profit or other economic loss suffered by the Customer, however caused.

15-Except as expressly set forth herein, Classical Coin Grading DISCLAIMS ANY AND ALL WARRANTIES, EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, REGARDING Classical Coin Grading GOODS AND SERVICES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

16-THE MAXIMUM AGGREGATE LIABILITY THAT Classical Coin Grading SHALL HAVE TO THE CUSTOMER SHALL IN NO EVENT EXCEED THE GRADING FEE ACTUALLY PAID FOR THE SERVICES RENDERED. IN NO EVENT SHALL Classical Coin Grading OR ANY OF ITS AFFILIATES, EMPLOYEES, OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, OR AGENTS BE LIABLE FOR ANY INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, OR EXEMPLARY DAMAGES.

17-In the ordinary course of its grading operations, Classical Coin Grading (i) compiles data regarding each coin submitted for grading, and (ii) may take photographs of each coin. The Customer agrees that Classical Coin Grading will own such data and photographs and may use them for commercial and other purposes, including publication and reproduction.

18-If coins are being submitted for a third party, the Customer represents and warrants that (i) the third party has been provided with a copy of these Classical Coin Grading GRADING TERMS AND CONDITIONS, and (ii) the third party has agreed to these terms and signed a duplicate copy. The Customer agrees to provide that signed copy to Classical Coin Grading upon request.

19-Classical Coin Grading REFUSES TO ACCEPT ANY RESPONSIBILITY, AND THE CUSTOMER HEREBY WAIVES ALL CLAIMS AGAINST Classical Coin Grading, IN THE EVENT OF ANY ATTACHMENT BY A CREDITOR OR SEIZURE BY ANY GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY OF ANY ITEMS SUBMITTED TO Classical Coin Grading.

20-Classical Coin Grading and its direct or indirect collaborators shall not be held liable for any risks associated with the transportation and/or custody of items delivered by the Client from the designated collection point (such as fairs, the Client's premises, or any other agreed location) to the headquarters of Classical Coin Grading and vice versa. This includes any period during which items are held in custody by Classical Coin Grading collaborators before delivery to the headquarters. The Client is solely responsible for insuring the transportation and custody of the items, even when utilizing the services of a collaborator of Classical Coin Grading for such purposes. In the event that the Client fails to secure insurance coverage, the Client shall fully indemnify and hold harmless Classical Coin Grading and/or its collaborators from any claims, damages, or reimbursements resulting from theft, robbery, seizure, loss, or any other events that may occur during transportation and/or custody.

21-These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by the laws of San Marino. Exclusive jurisdiction shall be granted to the court of San Marino for any disputes. The Customer agrees not to challenge the jurisdiction or venue of such a court.

22-These Classical Coin Grading GRADING TERMS AND CONDITIONS constitute the entire agreement between Classical Coin Grading and the Customer and supersede all prior agreements. If any provision is deemed invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain enforceable. The Customer agrees to execute additional documents as necessary to effectuate the terms of this Agreement.
